

English Year 10: Term 2

Course Content:

The Year 10 English Course Curriculum has a primary focus on the four aspects of language acquisition, namely: Reading, Oral/Speaking, Listening, and Writing Skills.

Students will undertake a module which focuses on violence in the media. This will involve developing student listening skills through watching various videos/documentaries, related vocabulary, academic writing skills, class debates, and will finish with formal letter writing.

Writing skills will be developed further this term through a Travel and Adventure unit. This will involve analysis of a range of texts, including various non-fiction travel stories. Students will study key vocabulary, as well as structure and form for academic writing. The final assessment will involve students producing their own journal writing based on an arctic expedition.
