		Overcoming Challenges and Adaptation	<ul> <li>Students discuss and share common challenges they have faced while working on their projects.</li> <li>Students brainstorm the solutions and reflect on adjustments made.</li> </ul>
		Celebrating Successes and Learning from Failures	<ul> <li>Students share successes and achievements on their projects</li> <li>Students discuss how failures and setbacks contribute to learning.</li> <li>Students learn the concept of growth mindset and reflect on their personal growth and development throughout the project.</li> </ul>
	3	Presenting the Completed Service Project	<ul> <li>Students present or display showcasing the project.</li> <li>Students discuss and share the project's impact on personal growth or the community.</li> </ul>
